TITANIC BELFAST

Discover the amazing story of RMS Titanic on a fascinating day visit to Titanic Belfast, the world's largest Titanic visitor experience.

Explore the sights, sounds, smells and stories of Titanic as you take an interactive journey through over 100 years of authentic history, at the very place where RMS Titanic was designed, built and launched in 1912.

SS NOMADIC

Known as 'Titanic's little sister', SS Nomadic has been restored to her former glory and is the world's last remaining White Star vessel.

Berthed next to Titanic Belfast is the SS Nomadic, the tender ship for first and second class passengers at Cherbourg. Designed by Thomas Andrews and built using the same design, it's similarities to RMS Titanic are plain to see.

HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDE:

- Restored to her original 1911 glory, see the original woodwork and wall panels that greeted passengers onboard.
- Explore Nomadic's fascinating stories, from a tender ship to her days in service in two world wars to her later life as an entertainment venue in Paris.
- Peek into the crew's quarters and the tunnels which allowed them to move around the ship, unseen by White Star Line passengers.
- Meet the ship's characters as they explain to you about their role onboard SS Nomadic. Watch out for Pierre the barman and Louis the stoker.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS THE MINIMUM NUMBER FOR A GROUP?

A minimum number of 15 paying guests are required for a group booking.

WHAT IS THE MAXIMUM NUMBER FOR A GROUP?

There is a maximum number of 53 guests per group booking. Should your group size exceed this, we can book multiple time slots for your group.

WHAT IS THE TIME BETWEEN EACH ENTRY?

Titanic Belfast operates on 10-minute time slots.

WHAT IF MY PREFERRED TIME SLOT IS NOT AVAILABLE?

Your Group Booking Advisor will assist with booking the next available time slot.

HOW LONG WILL MY RESERVED BOOKING HOLD FOR?

Payment is due within 30 days of confirmation of booking, or immediately if your groups arrival is within 30 days.

HOW CAN I MAKE PAYMENT?

You will be issued with a payment link once your booking is confirmed. Should you require an invoice, please let your Group Booking Advisor know.

HOW DO I ACCESS MY TICKET?

You will receive confirmation via email. It will contain a QR code and a voucher ticket attachment that our Visitor Experience Team will scan on arrival.

WHAT DO I DO ON ARRIVAL?

On arrival, please visit our Groups Desk, as they will provide your group with the Souvenir Ticket and a member of our Visitor Experience Team will be ready to meet your group.

HOW LONG SHOULD I SPEND ON MY VISIT?

We advise 1½–2 hours for the Titanic Experience and 1 hour for SS Nomadic.

LOCATION

Located in Titanic Quarter, Titanic Belfast is only 2.4km from Belfast City Centre. There are 478 spaces in Titanic Belfast's basement car park, plus additional parking throughout Titanic Quarter. Designated coach parking is available in the East Yard, located off Queen's Road

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- A group requires a minimum of 15 paying guests.
- Payment is due within 30 days of confirmation of booking, or immediately if your groups arrival is within 30 days.
- Once confirmed, numbers cannot be reduced or refunded.
- Amendments can be made to a booking until 4 working days prior to the arrival date.
- Additional guests on the day of your visit will be charged at the public walk-up rate (subject to availability).
