WHAT IS TITANIC BELFAST?

TITANIC BELFAST IS LOCATED ON THE SPOT WHERE THE FAMOUS SHIP WAS DESIGNED, BUILT AND LAUNCHED.

Inside this iconic building, the Titanic Experience shares the human stories behind the world's most famous ship. Through immersive galleries and storytelling, pupils explore Titanic's journey from creation to tragedy, connecting with the people behind the history.

A recent £4.7 million refreshment features *The Pursuit of Dreams*, showcasing original artefacts and a 7.6m long rotating ship model, brought to life with cutting-edge projections. It highlights Titanic's legacy, providing an engaging, educational experience for pupils.

As part of your school visit, you can step on board SS Nomadic, the world's last remaining White Star vessel and RMS Titanic's original tender ship. Walk the decks, explore the ship, and journey through over 100 years of maritime and social history.

Students will gain a deeper understanding of Titanic's story, uncovering the hopes and dreams of those connected to her. Through vivid storytelling and immersive experiences, the Ship of Dreams is brought to life in a powerful and unforgettable way.

On arrival you will be supported by a welcome host, who will set the scene and give you advice before you enter.

The self-guided tour extends over ten interactive galleries where students will discover the sights, sounds, smells and stories of the ship, as well as the people and city that made her.

Following your self-guided tour, you can pay a visit to SS Nomadic and soak up the history of the ship.

Supported by downloadable resources which cover the activities and themes you'll find in the exhibition, and how these link with curriculum targets in Northern Ireland and Republic of Ireland, our self-guided tour allows you and your students to explore Titanic Belfast and the fascinating story of RMS Titanic at your leisure.

Your trained guide will steer you through the Titanic Experience, helping you and your students focus on the story of RMS Titanic; from why she was designed, how she was built and her luxurious fit-out, right up to the story of her wreck's discovery.

You'll be guided to appropriate activities, hear stories about Titanic's passengers and crew, and reflect on the tragedy of her loss.

Following your guided tour, you can pay a visit to SS Nomadic and soak up the history of the ship.



WORKSHOPS

Titanic Belfast offers interactive, curriculum linked workshops designed to provide you and your students with a more engaging and meaningful learning experience.

From personal stories of the shipyard to exploring different methods of communication from 1912, we offer a wide selection of immersive workshop topics covering a broad range of curriculum areas.

Workshops are available as add-ons to your visit to the Titanic Experience. Each can accommodate up to 35 pupils and must include two supervising adults.

In this fast-paced, hands-on workshop, pupils race against time to crack codes, decipher clues and uncover hidden messages, all using authentic communication methods from the era of Titanic. Working in teams, they'll test their wits and collaboration skills to unlock a box housing a significant Titanic object.

Delivered on board the historic SS Nomadic, this immersive experience brings history to life through

semaphore, Morse code and signal flags, challenging pupils to apply their knowledge with purpose as they complete a thrilling, time-bound quest.

Abandon Ship uses genuine life rafts and survival equipment, with a focus on developing pupil's transferable skills in communication, problem-solving and decision-making as well

as promoting self-confidence, critical thinking and teamwork.

Once they imagine they are aboard a scientific research vessel which has collided with an iceberg, students must 'abandon ship' and form a plan for rescue and survival using the items provided through creativity and working together to formulate an innovative strategy to overcome the challenges of the Atlantic.

Beginning with a fully immersive light and sound show, which introduces them to the people on board Titanic, students will use Edwardian artefacts, costume, and documents to unpack the mystery surrounding several passengers who boarded the famous vessel in April 1912.

Students will use thoughtfully designed clues to draw conclusions and present their case to the group about who their passenger was, where they came from, and why they were travelling on the Titanic. Through this engaging activity focused on problem-solving, teamwork, and creativity, students will explore life in Edwardian times and gain an insight into the conditions on board the world's most luxurious ocean liner.
